

Important note -The estimates above incorporate measure uncertainty and are conservative.

There are too few transects in the selected zones to accurately calculate estimate uncertainty due to the heterogeneous spatial distribution of the resources over the study site. It is therefore suggested to perform the statistical analysis using a larger sample size, i.e., including more habitat zones. Assessment results are available in the CSV files. Great care should be taken to avoid misinterpretation given the above statistical issue.

Legal-sized individuals (200 mm) represent 41 % of the total stock biomass. This low proportion is attributable to the common observation of small individuals in the survey compared to adults (see charts below) and is indicative of local recruitment.
